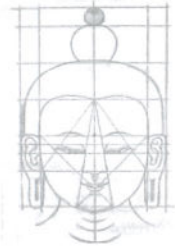

Initiation in to Tibetan Buddhist Sacred Thangka Painting



The Thangka painting is considered one of the five major sciences in the field of Tibetan Buddhism. The Sacred Thangka painting is destined to transmit serenity through a representation; this is called "Liberation through the sight".

When I paint, I absorb myself in to a profound serenity, which I then try to express on to the canvas so that it may in turn inspire the same serenity in all those who behold it.

I am a simple artist of the Dharma who paints the Yidams with his heart. Without the teachings no paintings, and without the paintings one cannot access the teachings of the Vajrayana...

Karma Yeshe is considered one of the rare masters of the Sacred Paintings. Born in Bhutan and grandchild of a famous Nyingmapa yogi, he studied under master Tchime in Bhutan and later with master Kunzang in Nepal. He has been a resident at the Kagyu Ling temple in France since 1986, where he has been ornamenting the main temple with frescoes.
